INSTRUCTIONS

FRESH START can be used as a mild spray solution or a full strength wash. Just adjust the strength to fit your particular cleaning job. Start with the recommended dilutions, but you may find it necessary to use more or less cleaner to adjust to varying cleaning problems. For the small job, apply FRESH START to damp cloth or sponge and wipe. For the very tough job on hard surfaces dilute FRESH START 2 to 10 and use Scotch Brite scour pad as needed on Barbecue grills, stoves, burners, ovens, grates, pots and pans and buildup of soap, mold and mildew on bathroom and shower area.

Recreational equipment such as vans, campers, boats, RV's, tents, sleeping bags, hunting, fishing, and sporting equipment can benefit from the use of FRESH START for exterior cleaning problems, and interior cleaning of carpets, ovens, upholstery, and mildew. Great for removing tree stains, mildew, mold and dirt from portable awnings on mobile homes and semi-tractors. Great for any baked-on enamel surface.

To remove most stains dilute FRESH START 2 to 30 with cold water moisten stained area; leave for a few seconds wipe dry and repeat as necessary. FRESH START will remove the following types of stains: soft drinks, chocolate, coffee, tea, milk, cream, fruit juices, alcoholic drinks, beverages, blood, ink, lipstick, cosmetics mascara, grass, gravy, ice cream, iodine, jam and jelly, ketchup, adhesive tape, margarine, pencil and crayon marks, soap, spaghetti sauce, urine, soups, mustard, egg and more.

GENERAL CLEANING

FRESH START diluted 2 oz. to 30 oz. of water is a General All Purpose Cleaning Mixture. Spray your counter-tops, furniture, paneling, wood-work, upholstery, appliances, light fixtures, ceramics, stainless steel, patio and pool furniture, Venetian blinds and any metal surface. Spray mist and wipe dry FRESH START may be used full strength for tough problems such as rust, road tar, driveway cleaning, decreasing car engines, glue and soap buildup. Apply to area buildup. Apply to area to be cleaned and let stand for up to five minutes, then wipe off with clean cloth. On any metal surface such as motorcycles, house siding, autos and trucks, etc., do not use full strength in hot sun or while surface is hot, let it cool down, spray with cold water hose then apply FRESH START, hose again.

CLEANING SMEAR PROOF WINDOWS & MIRRORS

1. Apply FRESH START diluted 1 oz. to 1 gallon (128 oz.) or 1/4 oz. to 1 quart (32 oz.) water with spray mist or cloth.
2. Use clean, dry cloth to buff glass completely dry. (This mixture can also be used for windshields, bathroom mirrors, motorcycle guards, swimming masks or goggles, eye glasses, TV screens, ceiling fixtures, etc.) Cleans and protects in single action. Helps resist 75-80% of natural hand oils and unwanted fingerprints.

PLASTIC, PLEXIGLASS, FIBERGLASS & VINYL

FRESH START diluted 2 oz. to 30 oz. water is an excellent cleaner of all plastic products, for porous or textured surfaces. Use a soft brush for problem areas.

CARPETING

Note: Always test for colorfastness when using FRESH START on carpets, upholstery, fabrics and spot cleaning. FRESH START can also be used to clean carpeting, either as an individual stain spot, or can be used to do an entire room. Some of the common stains FRESH START can remove are: grease, wine, liquor, soda, pet stains, gum, oil, coffee, glue, paint, grape juice, candle wax, some inks, vomit, water stains, and hair dye

TO REMOVE STAINS FROM CARPETING

1. Spray a solution of 2 parts FRESH START to 30 parts water onto stain; let it stand for 20 seconds.
2. Cover with towel; step on it with a twisting motion to soak up stain.
3. Rub dry with second towel; repeat if necessary until stain is removed.

TO REMOVE CHEWING GUM, CANDLE WAX OR HARD GLUE

1. Take a pin or sharp instrument and punch hole in object.
2. Dilute FRESH START 2 oz. to 30 oz. water. Spray on objects and let stand for two minutes to emulsify. Use nylon brush to help remove.

TO CLEAN CARPET WITHOUT MATCHING

1. Vacuum carpet.
2. Dilute FRESH START 2 parts to 10 parts water for badly soiled carpet. For regular carpet cleaning, use 1 part FRESH START to 15 parts water.
3. Apply with a soft bristle brush or sponge mop to loosen soil.
4. Wipe badly soiled areas with clean towel if necessary.
5. Vacuum

TO CLEAN CARPET WITH MACHINE

(Machine with rotary brush is best)

1. Vacuum carpet.
2. Dilute FRESH START 2 parts to 10 parts water. Pre-spot heavily soiled areas.
3. Add same mixture to machine. (For best results lightly spray a 12x12 area with garden sprayer before using machine. This gives FRESH START time to break up soil.)
4. Use machine slowly - move at a slow pace.

TO CLEAN CARPET WITH STEAM EXTRACTION SYSTEM

The use of hot water or "steam extraction" systems have shown considerable growth in past years. Often referred to as "steam cleaning", this system does not actually use steam, but rather hot water under pressure. This hot water is immediately vacuumed up, bringing with it loosened and dissolved soil. FRESH START is excellent for this type of cleaning. Dilute FRESH START 2 oz. to 30 oz. of water for this type of cleaning. If heavily soiled, you may want to go to a 2 oz. FRESH START to 15 oz. of water mixture.

TO CLEAN JEWELRY (Diamonds, Gold, Silver)

For the ultimate cleaning and care of fine jewelry, FRESH START is a must. Dilute 2 oz. FRESH START to 10 oz. water in a bowl or jar. Immerse jewelry for five minutes. Remove and scrub with old toothbrush. Rinse with water and buff dry with a cotton cloth. The shine and sparkle will amaze you.
